\$500 Scholarship

REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must have applied for admission to and subsequently be accepted and enroll as a degree-seeking student at a public or private four-year college/university, or a two-year community college, or a Christian program on the mission field, or an apprenticeship, or a vocational school.
- Applicant must provide evidence of compliance with the Virginia homeschool statute 22.1-254 or provide an exemption.
- All four years of high school must have been completed as a homeschool student.
- Two signed letters of recommendation from non-family members are required. Letters can be from a community leader or someone involved with the applicant, such as an employer who can attest to the student's character, extra-curricular activities, or community involvement.
- Current member of GRHE as of September 2020.

RULES:

- Applicant must complete all information on the scholarship application and meet all requirements. Applicant must also submit all required documentation. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- Letters of recommendation must meet the following guidelines:
 - 1. Letters must be from a non-family member.
 - 2. The writer of the recommendation must identify himself (or herself), indicate the context and length of time of the relationship with the applicant, and include contact information (phone number, address, and e-mail address).
 - 3. Signed letters of recommendation must be included with the application and mailed to GRHE Scholarship, P.O. Box 20938, Roanoke, VA 24018
- Scholarship funds will be payable directly to the college, school, or program to which the student has been accepted.
- If the scholarship funds are not used within 12 months of the award, the funds will be null and void and GRHE scholarship will be deemed ineligible.
- By entering the scholarship contest, students agree to abide by the rules and must meet all eligibility requirements. Each applicant must acknowledge that the entry is their own original document, and that it does not violate or infringe the rights including, without limitation, copyrights, trademark rights, or rights of publicity or privacy of any third party.

- Must be an original composition written by applicant.

- Essay should be double-spaced.
